

# DSAB Annual Report Summary 2018/19

There are 6 sub groups and 2 working groups of the DSAB which meet quarterly to support the Board in achieving its objectives.

The DSAB has been statutory since 2015 in line with The Care Act 2014. The Board met 4 times during 2018/19



796,100 people live in Derbyshire, 22% of the population is aged over 65



3587 safeguarding referrals were made during 2018/19



1300 safeguarding enquiries took place under S42 of the Care Act 2014.



The most common location for people being abused was at home (36%). The most common risk identified was neglect 24.89%



The majority of safeguarding referrals were made in relation to women over the age of 65.



In 31.7% of cases the adult was deemed to lack capacity to make decisions in relation to the safeguarding enquiry and an advocate was used in 77% of these cases to support the adult.



91% of adults who were asked said that their outcomes were fully or partly achieved in the safeguarding process.



During 2018/19 the DSAB delivered training to assist professionals with chairing multi agency meetings and Making Enquiries under S.42 of the Care Act 2014.

Two Safeguarding Adult Reviews (SARs) took place and SAR17A was signed off by the DSAB.



The DSAB team ran events in the community and had DSAB stalls at conferences to share information with the public and professionals about safeguarding adults. We co-produced leaflets and website content with the service user group, Derbyshire Stakeholder Engagement Board.
